

Curriculum Information
 Autumn 2 – Reception

Literacy	Using sounds learned in phonics to write simple words, writing tricky words -Reading words by breaking down the sounds, recognising <i>tricky</i> words.
Maths	Recognising numbers 1-20, ordering numbers 1-20, writing numbers 1-20, and matching numbers to quantities, 2-D shapes.
RE	Why is Christmas special for Christians
Topic	<i>Let's Pretend</i>
PSED	Learning to accept delays if needs aren't met immediately, taking turns, learning the skills to solve minor conflicts with peers independently, compromising.
Music	Learning various songs and dances, experimenting with instruments and rhythms and following and copying different beats
Spanish	Numbers, simple instructions, greetings, days of the week
Homework	Reading books are sent home on Fridays and the children should read it several times throughout the week. Spellings will also be sent home during this term. The children will get up to 6 new words each Friday



to practise **reading and writing** over the week. On Friday's the children will practise writing these words in a special book.

How can you help at home?

Reading - Please ensure your child reads on a daily basis for 5= 10 minutes and that you sign your child's reading log every day to say that they have done this. Please can you ask your child questions about the text and to retell what they have read? This will help to develop comprehension skills. Please remember to reread the whole sentence once a tricky word has been solved. This helps to develop fluency.

Spellings- Please practise reading and writing the spelling words several times weekly.

Numbers: Activities involving number recognition, number writing and matching would be very helpful. Having a secure knowledge in numbers 1-20 will help the children dramatically in their maths work.
