 Summer 1 – Year 2

English	We shall be reading Grace and Family. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Recounts - Sequels - Letters - Diary Entries
Maths	This term we will be focusing on all areas of maths to prepare the children for their upcoming SATS. We have identified key areas for each child and will be covered through additional lessons during assembly times and some afternoons.

How can you help at home?

Reading - Please ensure your child reads on a daily basis for 10 – 20 minutes and that you sign your child's reading log every day to say that they have done this. Please can you discuss the plot and characters as well as the meaning of new words children encounter. This will help to develop comprehension skills. Please remember to reread the whole sentence once a tricky word has been solved. This helps to develop fluency.

Times tables - Please ensure your child practises their times tables on a daily basis as part of their homework routine. (Please include which times tables the children should be learning for their age.)
