 Spring 1 – Year

English	We shall be reading 'The Princess and the White Bear King' - Newspaper reports - Recounts - Sequels - Letters - Diary Entries
Maths	This term we shall be covering the following areas: - Place Value - Addition - Subtraction - Division - Money - Statistics - Fractions At the end of each area we shall be doing an assessment to then recap and focus on key areas in the last week of term.
RE	This term we will be looking at: - Why do Christians Make and Keep Promises Before God?

How can you help at home?

Reading – Please ensure your child reads on a daily basis for 10 – 20 minutes and that you sign your child’s reading log every day to say that they have done this. Please can you discuss the plot and characters as well as the meaning of new words children encounter. This will help to develop comprehension skills. Please remember to reread the whole sentence once a tricky word has been solved. This helps to develop fluency.

Times tables – Please ensure your child practises their times tables on a daily basis as part of their homework routine. (Please include which times tables the children should be learning for their age.)
