Curriculum Information
Summer 1 – Year 3

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| English | Our new book this term is called <i>Charlotte's Web</i> and we will continue to learn a range of grammar over the upcoming weeks and work closely on improving our writing and comprehension. |
| Maths | This term we will continue learning about number and place value, geometry, fractions, decimals and percentages and statistics. |
| RE | In RE we will be learning about the Bible's big story. We will be looking closely at what it reveals about having faith in God. |
| Science | In Science this term, our first topic is 'light', where we will be focusing on reflection and shadows. Our second topic will be 'forces', where we will look at the concepts of push and pull. |
| PSHE | We will be discussing relationships such as friendships in the classroom and on the playground. We will also touch on emotional health, making good choices and dealing with uncomfortable feelings. |
| PE | Your child's PE days are Wednesday and Thursday . This term our topic is Athletics, we will be improving our sprinting, jumping and throwing technique in preparation for Sports Day. |
| Music | We will be developing our singing technique though learning a range of songs for the Music Festival. |
| Spanish | Spanish will take place on a Tuesday. |
| Homework | Homework will continue to be sent out every Friday and returned the following Thursday . Reading records will also be expected in every Thursday . |

How can you help at home?

Reading - Please ensure your child reads on a daily basis for 10 – 20 minutes and that you sign your child's reading log every day to say that they have done this. Please can you discuss the plot and characters as well as the meaning of new words children encounter. This will help to develop comprehension skills. Please remember to reread the whole sentence once a tricky word has been solved. This helps to develop fluency.

Times tables - Please ensure your child practises their times tables on a daily basis as part of their homework routine. This term we will be focusing on the 9 times tables.
