 Summer 1 – Year 6

I hope that you had an enjoyable Easter break. I am very excited to continue working with your children this year and look forward to helping them successfully through their SATs exams in May.

Please find below an outline of this half-term's teaching and learning:

English	Text: Time Travelling with a Hamster by Ross Welford
Maths	Preparation for SATS. Review of the following maths topics: Place value Area & Perimeter Geometry Order & sequences Algebra Arithmetic
PSHE	Good to be Me
PE	This term our topic is Athletics, we will be improving our sprinting, jumping and throwing technique in preparation for Sports Day.
Music	We will develop our composition skills as we write pieces in a range of styles using the keyboard and ukulele.
Spanish	This term in Spanish children will be learning to talk about their daily timetable (what time they wake up, have breakfast etc) and also how to talk about the weather in Spanish.
Homework	Homework will continue to be sent out every Friday and returned the following Friday. Homework will become a key focus as the SATs examinations get closer.



How can you help at home?

Reading - Please ensure your child reads on a daily basis for at least 15 minutes. This can be in short intervals if necessary.

This is a very important activity for all children to engage in, helping them with their spelling, punctuation and grammar skills. These skills are essential for their success in their SATs' **Reading** and **Spelling, punctuation & grammar** exams and beyond.

Children will be doing a lot in school to prepare them for the SATs, so please do not feel that children should be engaging in mock tests at home. Short bursts of revision/learning are recommended but nothing more would be advised.

Intervention groups will be taking place in the mornings and after school so children will be receiving a lot of additional help in school to fully prepare them for the tests.
