

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you had a relaxing break. We are looking forward to seeing the progress the children will make over this Spring Term 2. The topic for this term is;

Food/Shopping

During this topic, the children will have the chance to learn about various types of food and drink. We will discuss healthy/unhealthy food choices, talk about our shopping experiences, make shopping lists and go on a shopping trip. The children will also have the opportunity to engage in role play and creative activities.

Here are some of the areas that will be covered this half term:

Literacy	We will read a range of fiction and non-fiction books related to the topic. The children are on the Phase 2 phonics sounds. They will learn to recognise the initial sound in words and practice letter formations.
Maths	Count numbers up to 10 and beyond, recognise numerals and represent numbers using fingers and objects. Also, we will be learning to experiment with capacity by talking about which holds more or less and talk about the shape of everyday objects, e.g. 'round' and 'tall'.
RE	What is so special about Easter?

Books will be changed **every Friday** so please ensure that your child comes to school with their 'red bags' and with the previous book.
