What is the Sports Premium?

The Department for Education (DfE) are spending over £450 million on improving physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools over 3 academic years. The funding was first issued for the academic year 2013/2014 and it has continued and has extended beyond the 3 years. The funding will be allocated directly to primary school's to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all pupils.

Our school allocation

Our school has been awarded £13,983 for the academic year 2017 / 2018 and we intend to use the funding as outlined below.

CPD opportunities for NQT and new members of staff.	£1,650	2 x new members of staff received training, observed modelled teaching and team teaching to ensure teaching was at least good.
Lunchtime play equipment / resources audit and purchase of new equipment where necessary.	£700	New equipment has enabled the continued success of physical activity at break / lunchtimes and a revised activity programme run by staff. Up to 40 different children attended after school physical activities across the year promoting healthy lifestyles.
Delivery of 2 sports clubs weekly to improve physical activity and enjoyments of exercise and sports.	£3,485	Links with other school have remained and participation in football and tennis tournaments took place. Sports day was an amazing success and pupils enjoyed their rewards.
Two TA's to run a KS1 and KS2 lunch activity to continue to develop love for sport and improve physical activity.	£8,830	
TA to continue to maintain links with other schools to compete in competitor sports.	£3,089	
Purchase of medals and stickers for sports day as an incentive for effective participation and to reward winners and those that showed great effort.	£500	
Total estimated cost £14,013	Total actual cost £18,254	Difference £4,271
