

# Attending during closure

**From March 23rd, St Mary's will provide childcare to children who are vulnerable or that have EHCPs and children of key workers from Grasmere Primary School.**

Please read this section for key information.

## **The school day:**

The school day will be between 8.55am and 3.30pm. There is NO breakfast club and NO afterschool provision.

### *An example day:*

- 8.55-Register the children in the year 2 classroom
- 9.00-Do the Joe Wicks PE session
- 9.30-EY and KS1 children go into Reception class. KS2 children stay in year 2.
- 9.30-Reading
- 10.00-10.30 Phonics/Writing activities. Use a stimulus to get children writing.
- 10.35-Everyone meet in the Reception class for a snack.
- 10.45-11.00-Playtime.
- 11.00-11.30-Maths-Times tables, counting, mental arithmetic, practical activities such as measuring, use of White Rose and other maths resources
- 11.45-Reward/Relaxation/Free time
- 12-1.00- Lunchtime. All eat in the hall. Children to play in the KS2 playground or garden
- 1.00-1.30-Quiet time-Reading, yoga or other mindfulness activities
- 1.30-3.00-Creative Project- This could include the following subjects: science, Art, history, Geography, Design and Technology, Computing, Foreign languages.  
Make this as practical as possible e.g. creative play, drawing, construction, crafts, music, cooking
- 3.00-3.30-Share a story-Either read aloud, listen to or watch a story. Have some reflection time-Thoughts and feelings
- 3.30-Children to be picked up from KS2 playground

## **Accessing Grasmere school:**

Please use the garden gate in Church Walk at the beginning and end of the day and drop your child off in the KS2 playground where staff will collect the children.

## **Lunch:**

All children will receive a school dinner, but the children are also welcome to bring packed lunches in. PLEASE NOTE: the menu might well be different initially and allergies WILL NOT be catered for in the first instance due to potential supply issues.

## **Other information:**

You will be asked to complete the registration form and email to Mrs McKelvey prior to attending Grasmere.

At least 2 members of the St Mary's staff team will be working from Grasmere whilst St Mary's children are attending.

You might also be asked to provide evidence of key worker status. Please let the office have this at your earliest convenience. Thank you.
