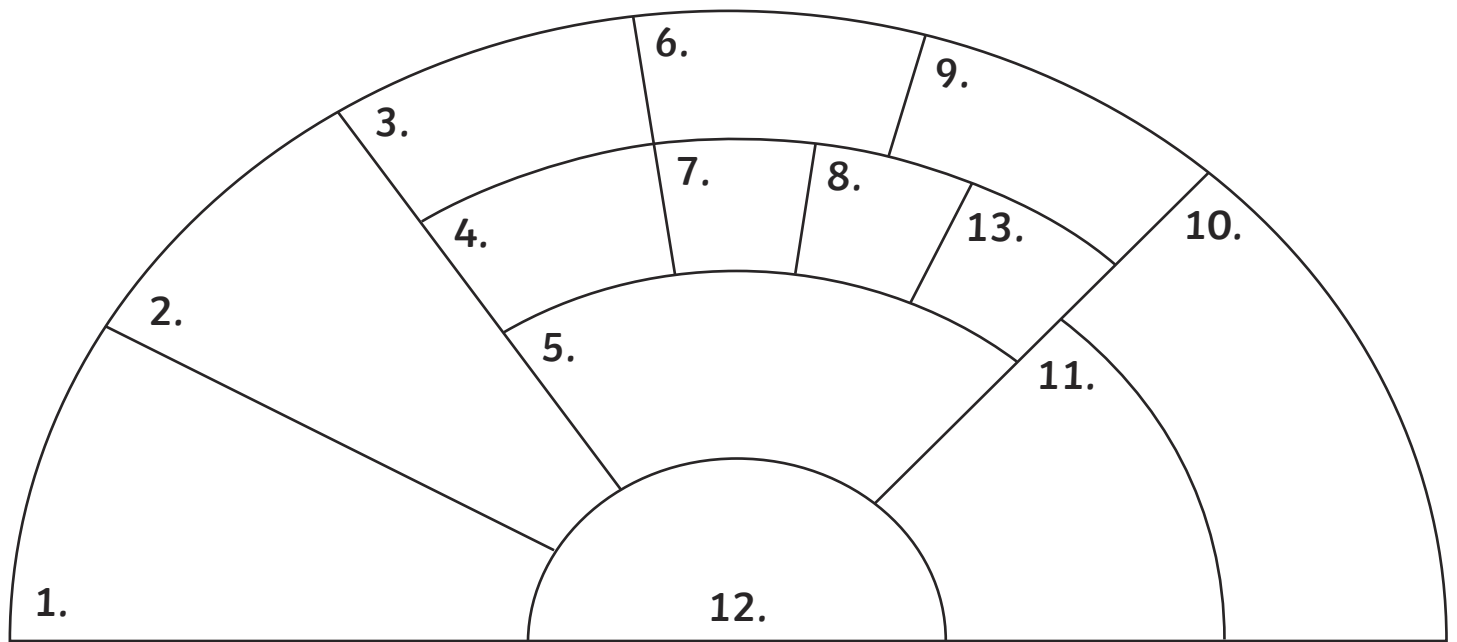


# The Classical Orchestra

Label the parts of the orchestra using the clues below.



## Clues

1. Smallest string instrument. Label this as the 1st \_\_\_\_\_.
2. Smallest string instrument. Label this as the 2nd \_\_\_\_\_.
3. Part of the percussion family. Consists of a family of deep-pitched drums.
4. Part of the woodwind family. Sound is produced by blowing across a small hole at the end of it.
5. Part of the string family. Slightly larger and deeper than the violin, but smaller than a cello.
6. Part of the brass family. It is made of tubing wrapped into a coil with a flared bell.
7. Part of the upper woodwind family. Sound is produced by blowing into the double reed and using both hands to press down on the keys to open and close the holes and change the pitch.
8. Part of the lower woodwind family. The first part of its name is the term used to describe the lowest voice in harmony.
9. Part of the high brass family. Sound is produced by buzzing into a mouthpiece and pressing on the valves.
10. Part of the string family. This is the lowest instrument of the string family.
11. Part of the string family. This is the second lowest instrument of the string family.
12. This person leads the orchestra.
13. Part of the upper woodwind family. This instrument was added to the orchestra during the Classical period.
