Reading

Homework Once the children have settled back into routine I will begin to send out homework. Homework will be sent out every Friday and it should be returned the following Wednesday.

Monday and Tuesday
Children will need to come to school in their PE kits on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. We will not be changing clothes in class.
