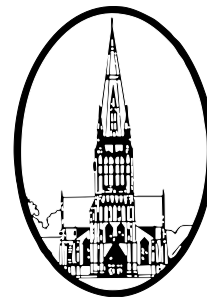

Curriculum Information

Autumn 2 – Year 1

English	Text: Lost in the Toy Museum by David Lucas Text: Traction Man by Mini Grey We will be practicing how to form sentences correctly, making sure they make sense and including all punctuation.
Maths	Number This term we will be exploring the following topics: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Place Value just beyond 10 - Addition and subtraction just beyond 10 - Multiplication and division - Length and Height
RE	Faith: Christianity Unit Name: Who is in the Nativity story and why are they important?
(Topic) History	Children of the Past – Toys and School.
PSHE	Who is special to us? Focusing on our relationships.
PE	Our PE days are on Monday and Tuesday.
Music	We will be continuing to explore playing the recorder and singing with Mr Cook.
Spanish	With Senor Enric – Revising numbers 1-10 and learning numbers 1-20, shapes, more colours, and classroom instructions.
Homework	Homework will be sent out on Friday – to be returned on the following Thursday. Little Wandle books will be sent out on Wednesday and to be returned the Friday of the same week.

Notices:

Reading – Please ensure your child reads on a daily basis for 10 – 20 minutes and that you sign your child's reading log every day to say that they have done this. Fluency and accuracy of reading is important, but it is also extremely valuable for you to ask your child questions about what it is they are reading so that they can develop important comprehension skills.

Important: The books that go home for reading on the Wednesday **must** be returned that same Friday. If books are not returned in a timely manner, there may be a charge.

Counting and number knowledge - Please ensure your child practises their counting on a daily basis as part of their homework routine. We are practising our 2s, 5s and 10s. Practising number recognition and making sure all numbers are facing the right way and are written correctly also encourages a stronger number sense. Practice the different symbols (+, - and =) and what they mean and where they sit in a number sentence. A strong knowledge of number bonds to 10 is highly helpful.

PE: Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit (white t shirt, black leggings, jogging bottoms and black trainers) on the PE days.

Water bottle: You must have a **labelled** water bottle in school every day.
