Curriculum Information

Spring I - Year 5

English	The books we will be focussing on this term are 'The Ice Bear'
	and 'A Boy and a Bear in a Boat'. We will be looking at writing
	organised non-chronological reports and playscripts based on our
	texts.
Maths	This term we will be focusing on converting between different units
	of time, exploring multi-step word problems related to addition
	and subtraction as well as multiplication and division. We will
	then be moving on to explore perimeter and area, including
	measurements of volume.
RE	In RE, we will be exploring how the first five Sikh Gurus shaped
	Sikhism.
Science	In Science this term, we will be answering two big questions.
	'What are things made from and why?' as well as 'Can we
	change materials?' The children will be conducting several
	experiments to conclude and answer these questions.
PSHE	In PSHE, the children will be thinking about first aid and how they
	can help in an accident or an emergency.





PE	Your child's PE day is on a Tuesday and Friday.
Music	This term the children will focus on singing.
Spanish	The children will be learning about tenses, routines and time.
Homework	Homework will continue to be sent out every Friday and returned
	the following Thursday.

## Notices

<u>PE</u> - Your child's PE day is every Tuesday and Friday. <u>Please ensure your child comes to school wearing their PE kit every Tuesday and Friday</u> as we will no longer change in school. The PE kit consists of a white t-shirt (or house team shirt), plain black bottoms, trainers and a school jumper.

Homework and home reading - Homework will be sent out every Friday and returned the following Thursday. Children are expected to read on a daily basis for 10-20 minutes.
