Curriculum Information  
Spring 2 – Year 6

<b>English</b>	In English this term we are continuing to read <i>The Highway Man</i> . In our lessons, we will focus on the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Role-Play and debate</li> <li>• Short writing pieces that focus on the use of grammar and punctuation</li> <li>• Free writing sessions where the children provide the stimulus for writing</li> <li>• In addition, we will be preparing for our upcoming SATS by focusing on how to answer specific types of questions and recapping our previous knowledge.</li> </ul>
<b>Maths</b>	This term we will be focusing on: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reasoning problems during our maths lessons.</li> <li>• The children will also have two booster sessions a week during the school day to help prepare for SATS.</li> </ul>
<b>RE</b>	In RE, our Big Question is: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How does the Christian festival of Easter offer hope?</li> </ul>
<b>PSHE</b>	Our PSHE topic this term is: How can the media influence people?
<b>PE</b>	Your child's PE day for this term is every <b>Tuesday &amp; Wednesday</b> . Running club will occur every Friday <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The topics are: Basketball and Netball</li> </ul>
<b>Spanish</b>	The children will have Spanish every Tuesday morning. This term they are focusing on describing appearances.
<b>Homework</b>	During this term the children will complete the <b>SATS books</b> for homework. The children should spend 4-5 minutes to an hour each night completing the books. They must keep a record in their homework books by writing the date and what they completed on that day. If they require any support with a topic then they should write a note in their homework book.  It would be very helpful if parents could please ensure their child is taking the time to complete the books every night.

**How can you help at home?**

**Reading** – Please ensure your child reads on a daily basis for 10 – 20 minutes and that you sign your child's reading log every day to say that they have done this.

**Times tables** – Please ensure your child practises their times tables on a daily basis as part of their homework routine
