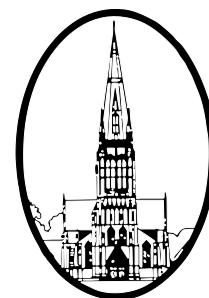

## Reminders:

### **Water bottle**
