## Notices:

**Reading** - Please ensure your child reads on a daily basis for 10-20 minutes and that you sign your child's reading log every day to say that they have done this. Fluency and accuracy of reading is important, but it is also extremely valuable for you to ask your child questions about what it is they are reading so that they can develop important comprehension skills.

Practice the different symbols (+, - and =) and what they mean and where they sit in a number sentence. A strong knowledge of number bonds to 10 is highly helpful.

Handwriting: Handwriting is on the homework every week and must be completed. We are trying to maintain a high standard in our work and role modelling what being proud of your work looks like.

PE: Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit on the PE days.
